#### If You Need to See a Doctor

You should go to Student Health Services (SHS) on campus for treatment first or to receive a referral. There is no copay at SHS. There are two Student Health Services locations:

If you must receive treatment outside Student Health Services, it is strongly recommended that you visit a PPO provider for treatment. In order for your medical bills to be paid at 100% (after copay) when you seek treatment off-campus, the doctor or hospital you visit must be a member of the Preferred Provider Organization (Blue Cross Blue Shield).
