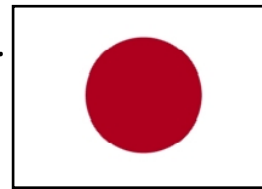
Important Reminders

- All outstanding Spring 2015 tuition fees must be paid by May 11th, before you can register for Summer 2015. Also, if a student wants to take advantage of priority registration for Fall 2015, all fees must be paid before June 15, 2015.
- If you are a student worker and you want to work during the summer, you must enroll in at least 3 units this summer to be eligible to work.
- Finals Week – May 18-22
While your scheduled classes end the week of May 18, please keep in mind the spring semester does not end until your final is complete. Check with your instructor and your Student Portal for the date and time of all of your final exams. They may not be the same day and time as your classes were scheduled.

Travel Advisory

International students who plan to leave the U.S. this summer, must get your SEVIS I-20 form signed before you leave. Without this signature, the US Immigration & Customs Enforcement may not allow you to reenter the United States. Please visit the International Student Program office **before** final exams begin on May 18 to obtain the required signature. Be sure you keep your important documents with you when you travel. You need a valid passport and visa to reenter the U.S. If your passport/visa has expired, or will expire by the time you travel, you must renew it before returning to the United States. You should be prepared to show the consulate officers your I-20 form, official transcripts from SRJC, and current financial documentation. You may be asked for this information again at the airport when you return to the U.S.

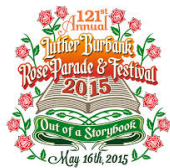
Luther Burbank Rose Parade & Festival
