Diversity Immigrant Visa Program 2016

Each year, the U.S. Department of State sponsors a "lottery" to award 50,000 *permanent residence* visas to persons meeting the eligibility requirements. Diversity visas provide an immigration opportunity for persons from countries that do not send large numbers of immigrants to the US. Applicants will be electronically selected at random. The online registration period is October 1 – November 2, 2015. Visit the U.S. Department of State website at: <http://www.dv-lottery.us/> for more information. Several of SRJC's international students have won the lottery in past years.



Alex Ling Memorial Scholarship

The Alex Ling Memorial Scholarship is available to international students who have already completed a semester at SRJC. The application deadline is October 09, 2015. The scholarship is \$475. Students must be currently enrolled with at least 12 units and have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Students must also enroll in at least 12 units at SRJC during Spring 2016. Optional Practical Training- Work Permission

Optional Practical Training (O.P.T.) is a benefit of the F-1 Student Visa status that allows for one year of full time employment to gain practical experience in your field of study. You must wait until you have earned an Associates degree before applying for this benefit. The employment must be directly related to your major. You can begin looking for a job a few weeks before you expect to receive your Employment Authorization card. Processing time for Practical Training applications is about 3 months, so you should submit your request 3 months before you wish to begin working. US CIS advises students not to leave the country while a request for work permission is being processed. Travel is possible once you have received your receipt notice or EAD card. You are not required to enroll in classes while on OPT.

Submit your completed forms, photos and documentation to Ms. Kim Hunt in International Student Programs. We will review your application and mail it to USCIS by certified mail.
